As Governor Inslee's [Safe Start Washington](#) phased response to the COVID-19 pandemic continues to progress, the Governor issued Phase 1 and 2 Religious and Faith-based Organization Covid-19 Requirements. We have developed our plan to re-open the Masjid in a phased approach in accordance with the Governor's requirements and with two guiding principles:

- Our members safety comes first; and
- We use the best public health and safety practices.

We're being cautious in the interest of our members and the public and the following is our plan to comply with the Governor's requirements:

1. We will open for Fajr and Isha prayers only starting Wednesday June 24, 2020.
2. COVID-19 safety information is posted in the main entrance.
3. All members and visitors must self-screen for signs and symptoms of Covid-19 before arriving at the Masjid. Monitor your health daily, and if you have any of the symptoms (fever, cough, shortness of breath) please pray at home. If you have a family member with these signs or symptoms, please pray at home as well.
4. Authorized access to the Masjid will only be the main entrance to the facility. All other access points will be closed.
5. Please come to the Masjid ready for prayer (with Wudu).
6. All members and visitors in attendance are required to wear face coverings before, during, and after prayer.
7. Bring your own prayer rug and make sure you don't leave it behind in the Masjid.
8. A disinfectant station is provided at the main entrance. Everyone is required to use the disinfectant as they enter the Masjid.
9. There may be no direct physical contact between members or visitors. Please refrain from shaking hands or giving hugs at this time.
10. No food or drink is allowed at this time.
11. Access to the restroom is limited to 2 people at a time. A sign is posted at each restroom. Individuals waiting to use the restroom must maintain at least 6 feet of distance between each person.
12. Soap and running water is provided. Please practice frequent handwashing.
13. High-touch surfaces such as doorknobs will be disinfected after each prayer.
14. Please adhere to physical distancing requirements. The prayer hall has been set up with at least six feet of space between individual prayer space.
15. Tissues and trashcans are placed throughout the Masjid.
16. Please leave immediately after done with prayer.

We are in this together and we need your help to follow the proper guidelines so that we can be allowed to keep the Masjid open and move to the next phase. Please comply with the guidelines and cooperate with our Imam.
